USES INTRUCTIONS

- 3. Rinse surfaces in contact with food with potable water.

- Liberally apply a pre-diluted solution of GENERAL to the floor.
- Leave on a few minutes for optimal results.
- Use a floor squeegee to direct solution towards the closest drain, or draw solution up with a wet mop.
