

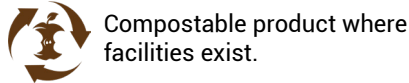
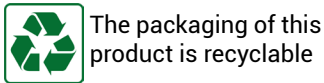


HOW TO DISPOSE OF OUR PRODUCTS AFTER USE ?

1. I reuse it.
2. I put it in the recycling bin.
3. I put it in the compost.
4. I put it in the garbage.
